This is an excellent project that gets your students outside! It can continue throughout the school year, covers Cross Curricular Competencies and uses all 7 learning intelligences and un-wraps the eighth....*the Naturalist Intelligence*. I recommend a 2 hour to ½ day program to launch this project with your class. I can return for a visit 2-3 more times to help with your project if your budget permits.




OUTDOORS IN GRADE 1-3 PROGRAMS

Creatively designed to fit your unit of study.




Seasons in your Schoolyard
